# *My Visit to Waterloo 4 May 2019*

As part of my Army Inspection of the US Army Garrison at Supreme Headquarters Allied Powers Europe (SHAPE) in Brussels Belgium we ended up having a weekend stay. I always bring along a painting kit with me to stay busy in the early morning (jet lag) and weekends. It gives me something to do and of course is very relaxing. I am able to get a lot of painting done also. I've been in Europe 8 days now and have completed: (all 28mm) 26 horses, 12 French Cuirassier and 12 Mexican Lancers.

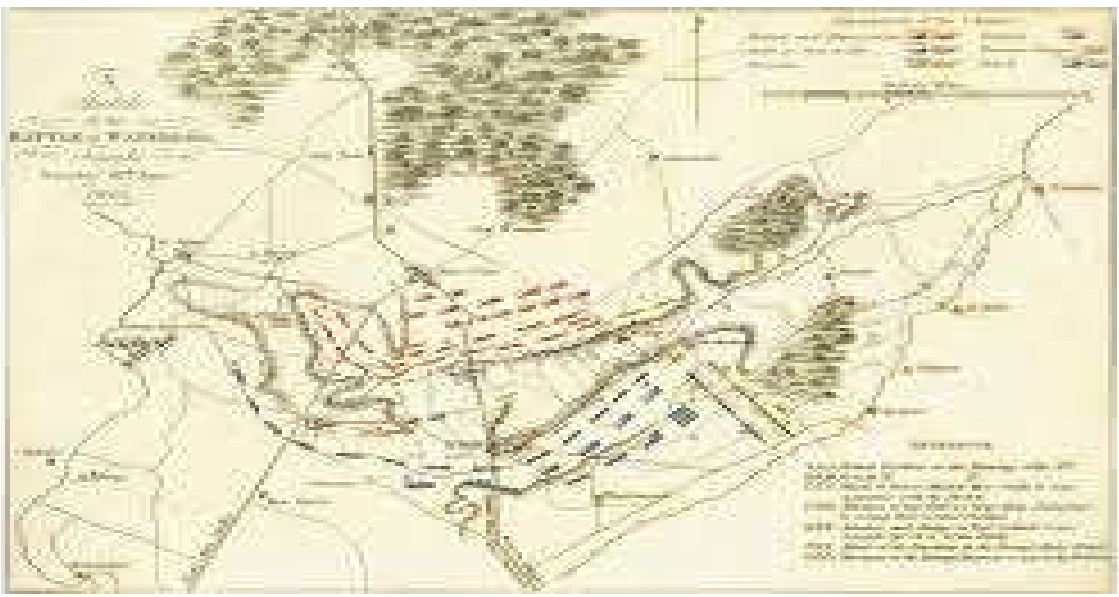


Three of us took time Saturday to visit the Waterloo battlefield about 30 minutes from USAG Benelux (US Army Garrison Belgium/Netherlands/Luxemburg) where we are staying. It was a cold rainy day but this did not stop us. The last time I visited Waterloo was 1996 when stationed in Germany.



The battlefield added a very nice museum with audio/video and artifacts that is simply OUTSTANDING. If you have never been to Waterloo – add it to your bucket list – a must visit for every student of military history and Wargamer.





As part of our visit I brought along the French Cuirassier regiment that I painted this past week – This unit will always be my “WATERLOO REGIMENT”. I suspect it will be my favorite in all my future Napoleonic battles.



I carried the regiment with me around the battlefield and took a picture outside the gate of the Houghoumont.

Third World War Thursday Update

## May Report

Chris (Israeli Pattons and Mercavas) and Rob (W. German Leopard Is) took on Tony and Nathanael (T-62 Battalion) in a capture the flag mission (3 objectives in the middle).



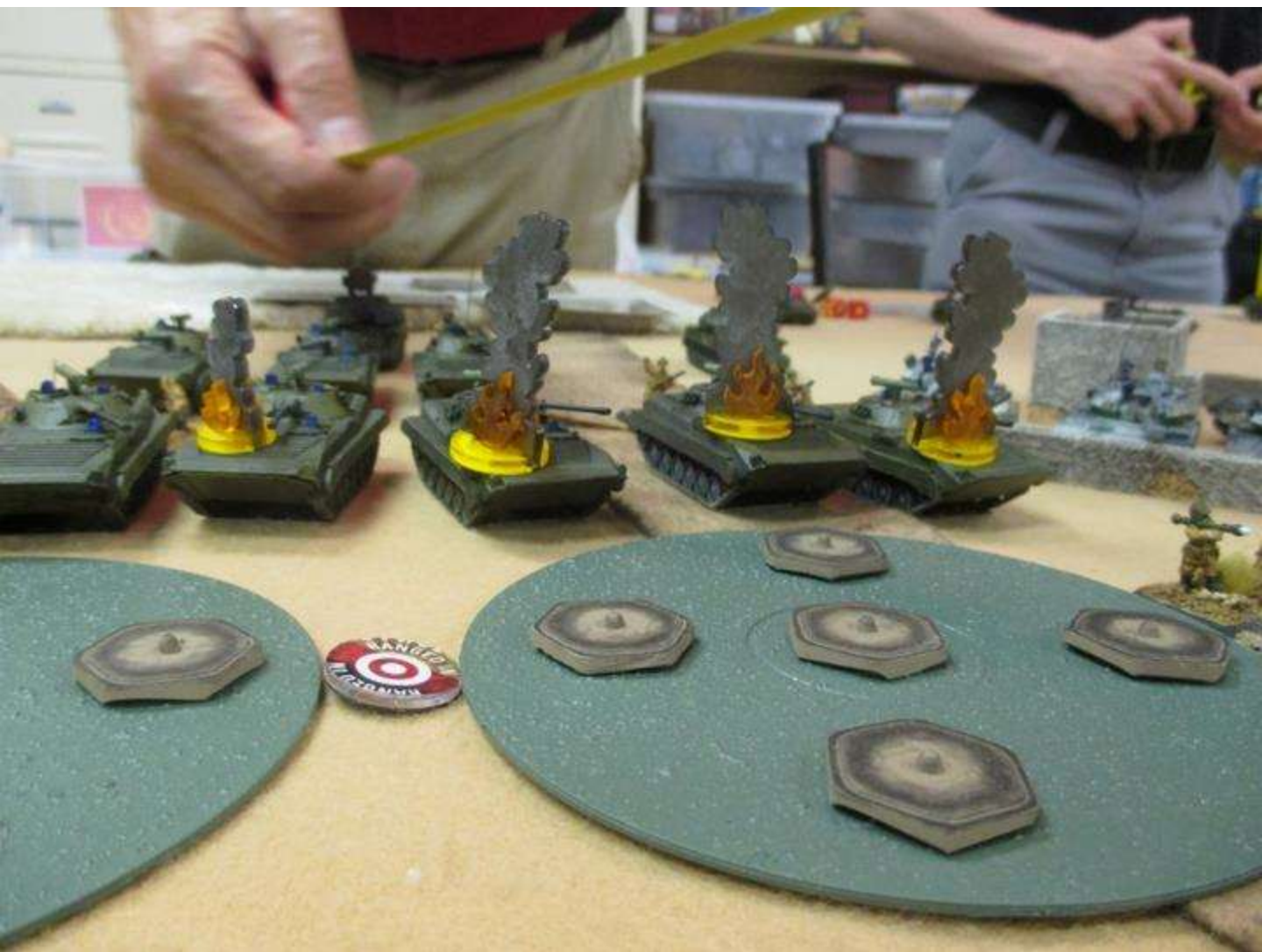


This was the much anticipated debut of Israel in Third World War Thursday with a platoon of 3 Mercava 2s supplementing a small formation of Magach 6s and infantry. The Soviets moved out sharply and after 2 turns had planted themselves on the left objective going around 2 ...minefields.



Their BMP transports were eaten alive by the Pattons while giving back a single casualty that finally resulted in a platoon morale failure. The right objective saw Rob's Leopard Is annihilate a whole platoon of missile equipped T-62s with a 2nd Soviet infantry unit and the Israeli infantry contesting the right objective.





The Mercavas were hesitant to leave the sanctuary of their palm grove in fear of 4 Hinds and 2 Frogfoots. However, since the Storm AT units were not quickly neutralized they backed out and away. Two IDF Viper helicopters were also intimidated to loitering by well placed Geckos that dominated the entire airspace.



Eventually, the Storms were neutralized as were the Geckos freeing the Mercavas and Vipers to engage more fully. The Leopard Is were eventually taken down by combined T-62 and Storm fire.





At the end, the 3 Mercavas were on the middle objective having just destroyed one of the last three T-62s on the table. Front armor 19 on the Mercava 2s (no casualties) and Brutal main guns on both the Pattons and the Mercavas made up for the relatively mild AT of 19 of their main guns. More good battles ahead.

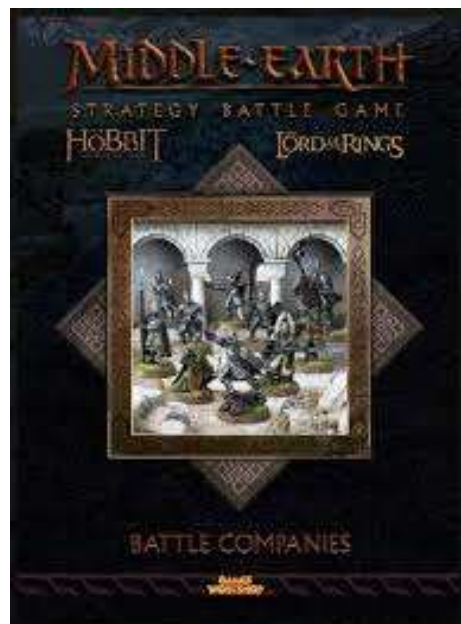

An odd bunch of Trolls wandered down into Rohan on their usual plundering trip, but Theoden, Grimbold, and a few brave men rode out to meet them in the black of night.



Closing in on the Troll's campfire, the Riders spend several turns launching spears and arrows at the beasts, but only landed one solid hit (resulting in a wound). In return several Riders were crushed by boulders and tree stumps.



Enraged by the failure, several men rush into the blackness of the woods, finding nothing good. Brave enough to charge in, but not bold enough to land and hits, several more were crushed or thrown about. After three rounds of charging in and doing no damage, the only bright spot for Rohan was a boulder thrown by a Troll that hit another Troll.

Not to be considered un-brave, Theoden spurred in his mount and charged with 4 others in support - and again, failed. Pulled from his horse and ripped in half, the poor horse lord is likely a meal. His surviving war-band members bravely ran away...



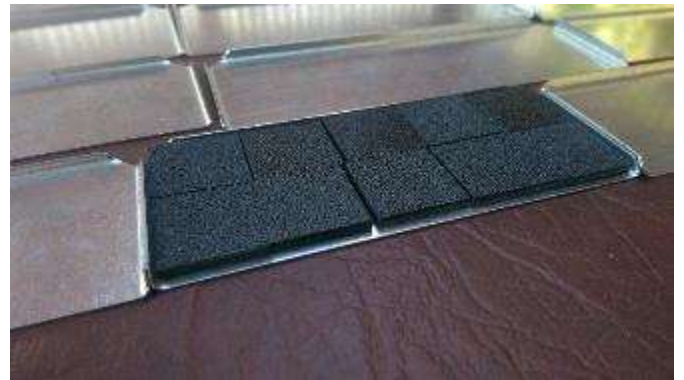
The takeaway - shooting is not a great tool in the hands of men - and definitely not great at bagging Trolls and other large critters. And when your Duel dice fail you, even having numbers on your side doesn't help (for 5-ish rounds of combat, Rohan never won).

Now Mestrius' gang must escort the careless Dominus out of the market square before he is killed by Autobus' gang.



Autobus' gang closes in as well as one of Lucretia's wily fighters. Lucretia's other fighter Manlius stayed in the shadows sending a sling stone flying to no result. 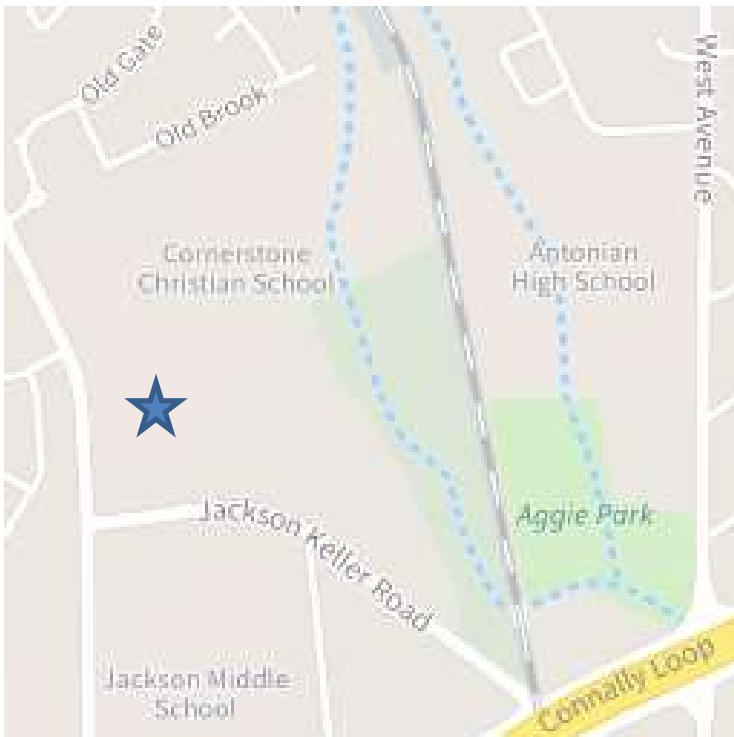

# Spectre Ops

## Game Report

With the release of the 2d Edition of Spectre rules, me and Casey have been getting in some learning games (2 games in 2 weeks) to get the mechanics down.



I will say I had been a stalwart supporter of Force on Force for my modern gaming, but these new rules are rapidly pulling me in their direction. Basic functions are streamlined, easy to follow, and quick playing once you've run thru the drill once or twice. You can go "deep" into the detail, but I'll avoid knitting out a team with advanced dive gear as I'm really only interested in standard line units fighting one another - not a SEAL team mauling a militia.



So far we've pitted a Professional Russian and US force against one another, then a Trained Russian force vs a Pro US force. There is a differentiation in force levels, but we have not seen any imbalance as both sides are effective if managed properly. Combat is lethal - I don't see drawn out gunfights happening, and it will force you to think, shoot, and move.





We are slowly scaling up with more minis and vehicles to see where we hit the point of diminishing returns (hoping it holds together at a reinforced platoon level without being slow in play) and will eventually get in some of the lesser troop types against better troop types and see how it manages.

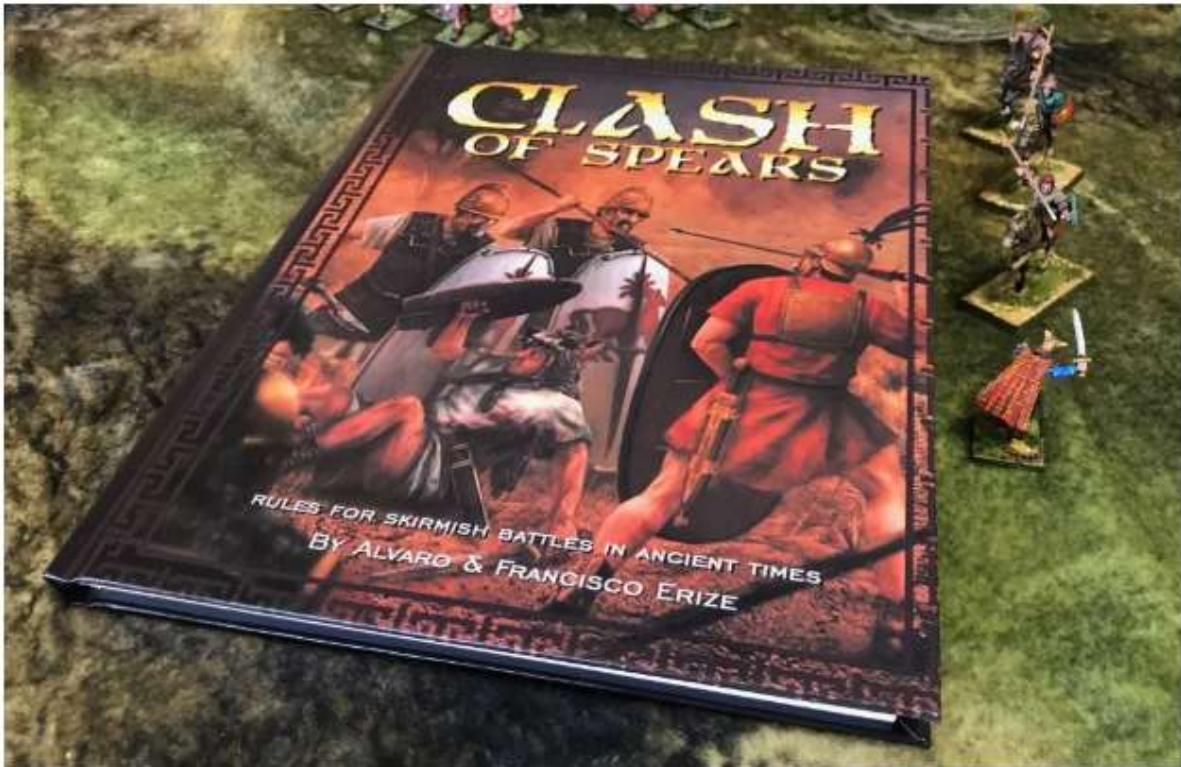

# 2019 Dallas Open GT Bolt Action After Action Report



The Dallas Open GT took place at the Grapevine Convention Center April 13<sup>th</sup> and 14<sup>th</sup> and was a great time for everyone who made it out! This was the first year that Bolt Action was a featured game, as it has been a 40k focused tournament in the past.





The event had a total attendance of around 200 gamers playing several different games. Bolt Action players had a dedicated space, two vendors selling both supplies and Warlord products, and a TO from the War Games Tournament Circuit meaning that scores would count for those interested in the new rankings system.



Players attending created 1250-point armies following several rules including being restricted to the Armies of XXX books (or the book the army's generic reinforced platoon was introduced) and a dice cap. There was a diverse range of armies as American, German, Soviet, Finnish and Chinese Nationalist armies all made an appearance. The terrain supplied included a table of ruins and hedgerows, several jungle style terrains with bunkers/trenches, an urban table with multiple story ruins, and several tables with desert style terrain complete with small villages. Five scenarios were included giving an opportunity for players to use their armies to secure objectives, eliminate the opposition or to seize an opponent's HQ.



This two-day tournament featured five total games with around two and a half hours per game. Almost all players finished each game even if they went seven rounds. Prize support for the tournament was outstanding and was not only tied to where players finished.

- Jacob Mayer finished as Tournament Champion with his Soviet Army and earned a Soviet Tank Wars Starter Army (could not also win Best Allied General)
- Larry Light finished as Best Axis General and earned a DAK Starter Army
- Clayton Marberry finished as Best Allied General and earned a U.S. Starter Army
- Two awards were given for “Best Painted Army” and “Judges Choice” awarding a Warlord Armor Kit and two of the new Warlord Paint Sets
- The Wooden Spoon award was a K47 Starter Set and a new set of German Dice with a German Dice Bag
- All other players received custom objective markers, an army themed set of pin markers, a Warlord Metal Sculptures Set and a Campaign Book
- There were also prizes for FUBARs and an initial swag bag that included a detail paintbrush and several other prizes (and even a \$5 coupon for the local craft brewery)
- Charles Marberry was the overall drawing winner for the entire event – he won an Alpha Gaming Table (portable, 4’x6’ gaming table) valued at around \$250

Plans to include Bolt Action next year are already in place and we are hoping to grow the overall size and numbers of entrants. We look forward to making this a must attend event where people from all over Texas can get together in a great venue with great prize support and tables! Hope to see you next year!

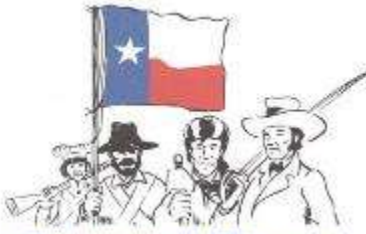

Some LSHM members will fondly remember the 1980's era micro games produced by Steve Jackson out of Austin. Some of these games included Car Wars, Ogre, Illuminati, Melee, Assassin and others. Most of them were very strategic and often had a sci-fi theme. The company, Steve Jackson Games, is still in business and currently its most popular game is the Munchkin card game.



We have seen Steve Jackson Games at MillenniumCon . Mack Harrison runs his massive Ogre Miniatures game every year. In 2017, a representative came and ran a session of Car Wars. Mike Becnel, who runs a regular Aerodrome game, worked on the original Car Wars rules and the image of his face is used on the box art.

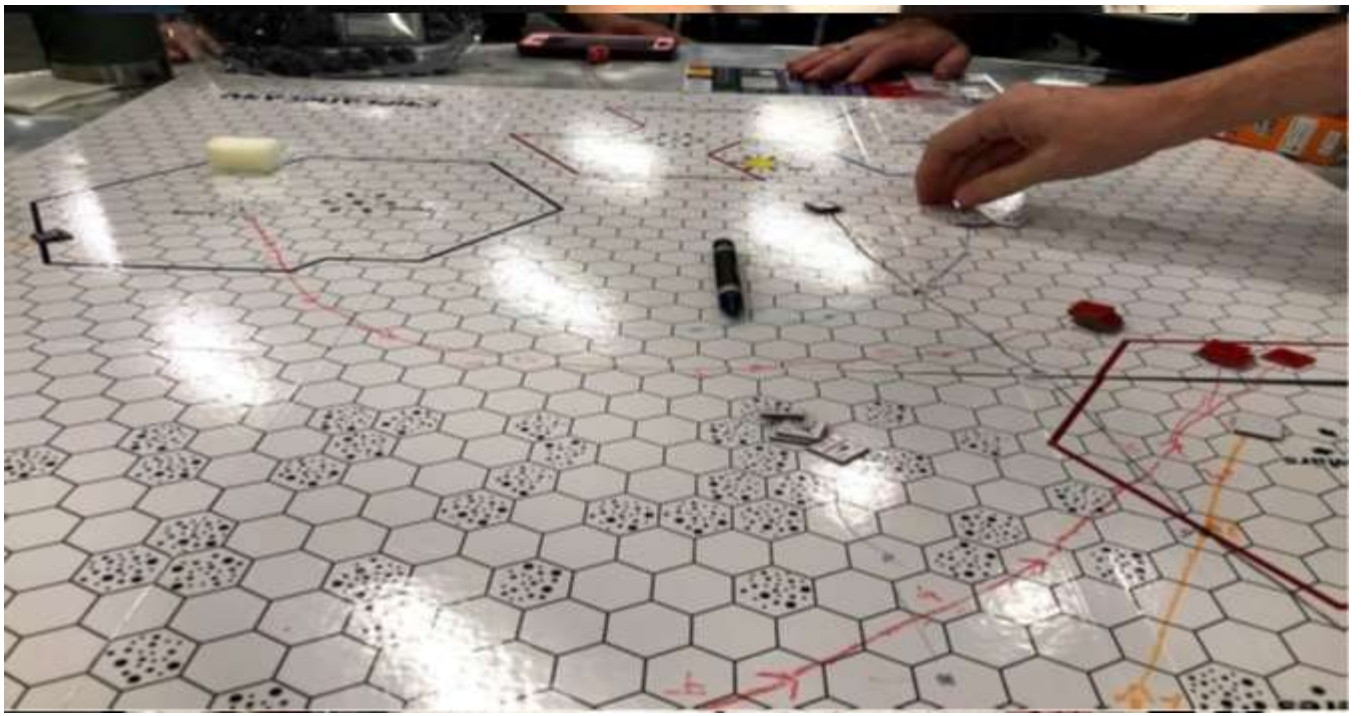


The company has been in business for nearly 40 years. They ran a few Kickstarter campaigns to help reprint some of these classic games. And, for the very first time, the company hosted a convention for these games. It was called FnordCon and was held a few weeks ago in Austin. It was a two-day event but I was only able to be there for one day. It was an excellent event.

The day started early. I met up with Mack and drove to the location. There was a long line to get into the convention but the staff managed it well. I received a swag bag full of freebies. I participated in an open beta-test of the newest sixth edition version of Car Wars. CW is one of my most favorite games and I was impressed by the new version.



The current game designers have modified the game a little bit to meet the standards of a modern strategy game. The new version includes lots of cardboard devices to help manage the status of each player's car, which is a significant change. Another major difference is the game is no longer played on grid paper but it is a wide open map. We were never given a paper copy of the rules (the game is still in development) and that slowed down the game play. For the most part, the game is still fun and feels very realistic.



Mack brought his copy of TriPlanetary, a sci-fi strategy game, and played a quick pick-up session. TriPlanetary is set in the future and the map is a representation of the Solar System out to Jupiter. Typical scenarios involve racing, pirating, invasions, and a few others. Movement involves vector mechanics. Players plot courses for their space ships using a grease pencil on the map. The gravitational pull of planets and moons are used to modify the trajectory of your space ships. Looked like fun!



Later that day, we got into another beta-test game. This time it was a test of the newest map for Ogre. We ran a standard scenario where a single, gigantic, cybernetic tank, called an Ogre Mk III, is deployed on a planet with the mission to destroy the enemy command post. The Command post is defended by infantry in battle suits, standard tanks, and ground-effect vehicles. The new map was designed to create new tactical situations that wouldn't occur in the standard maps. Mack and I each played a game running the Ogre. In both games, the Ogre was successful, so the added terrain probably hindered the standard ground units.



Since it was a convention, there is no way I was leaving without buying something. So, I purchased the latest box sets for Melee and Wizard. The original game called Melee, is a man-to-man combat game in a fantasy setting. You create a character just like you would in an RPG but the characters are very simple with only two characteristics, Strength and Dexterity. Then, you kit out your character with weapons and armor. Then, you engage in combat with your opponent's character on a hex map. Wizard is the expansion to the original game. It adds spells and magical attacks to the basic game.

The rules are unchanged from the original 1982 version. I had played it before years ago, but it took some time to get familiar again. We played out several battles. In each battle, we swapped out different equipment and armor, trying to find out the best combination of speed, strength and weapon selection. The game comes with cardboard pieces but miniatures can easily be used to add some visual interest. Maybe I'll run a session of Melee at the upcoming MillenniumCon!

FnordCon was well organized by the staff and I would consider it a success. Unfortunately, they didn't have pre-registration and I missed a few sessions that I really wanted to attend. Overall, it was a good little convention. I will definitely attend if they do another one.

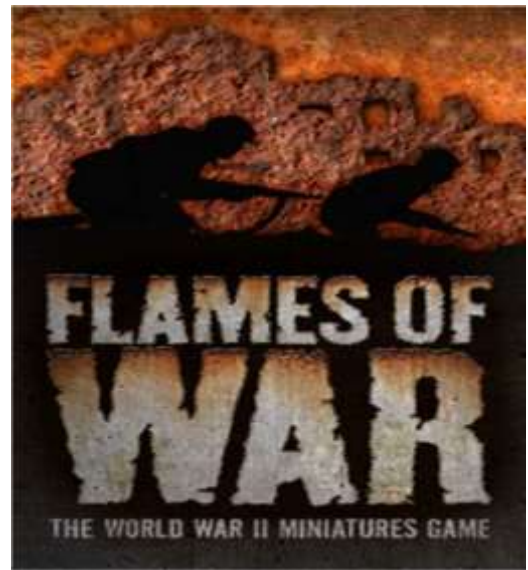

List in early, by July 20th: That.s the preceding Saturday: Get to place an extra trench in one mission.

List in earlier, by July 13th: Additional +1 list point bonus, and get to re- roll one roll deciding whether you attack or defend.

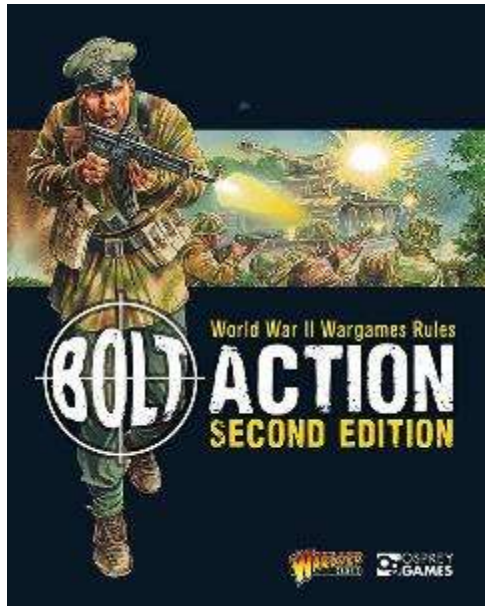

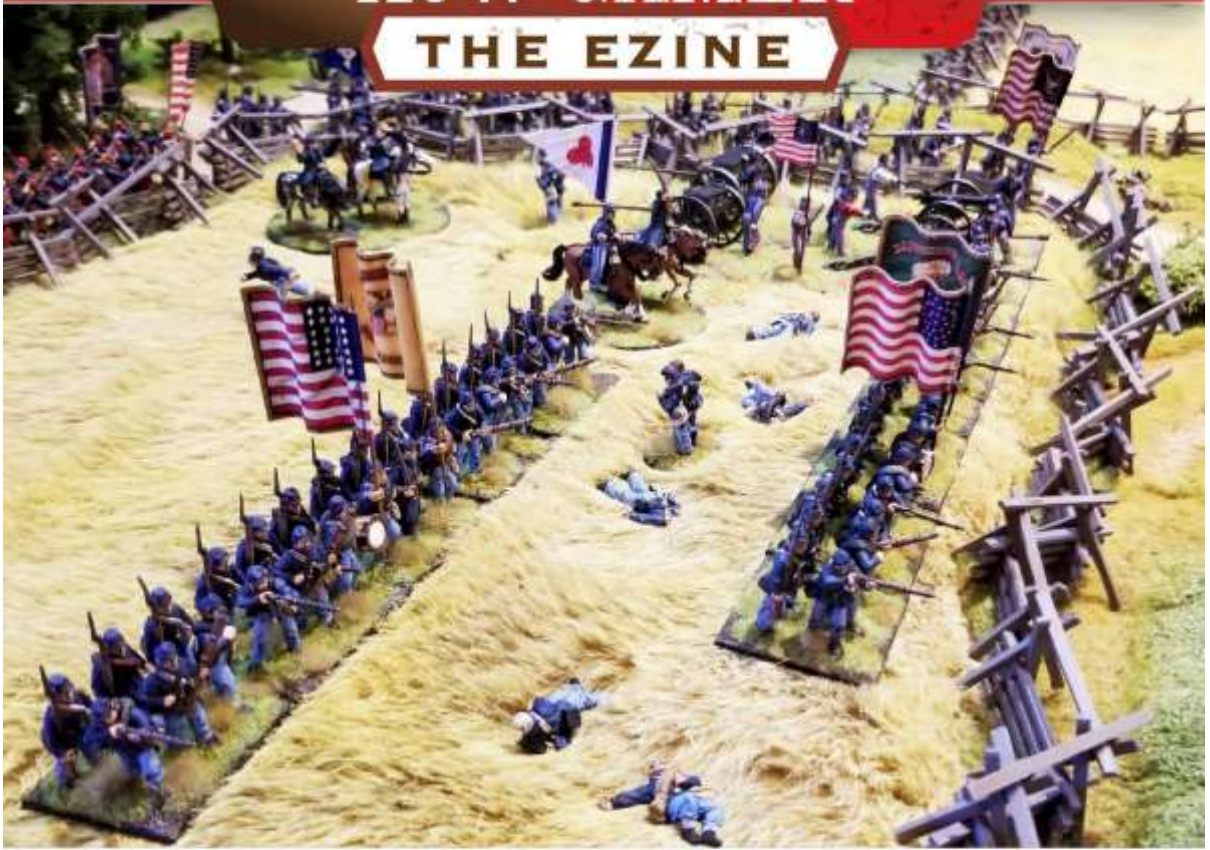
