### What does this mean to you?

First, pre-register @ [register@baneofwar.com](mailto:register@baneofwar.com) in paypal @ \$30.00- Allowing 22 allied and 22 axis armies, so sign up soon! Armies should only be chosen from the Late War books, or PDF's that are applicable to that period.

### Scoring –

Typical FOW scoring, adding a plus 1 if you win and either wiped your opponent, captured the objective, or reached the end of round 6. (*Timing someone out before round 6, and receiving the win will not give you the bonus point*).

### Special Rules –

ALL lists get the same free sporadic air, this will take your air slot but does not count against your points.

- 4/5/2+ bombs - 4/6/3+ rockets- 3/3/5+ mgs - NOT flying Tanks or jets.

US TD security teams that moved in the previous round causes the TD section to shoot as if moved, same if they moved that round.

Sportsmanship scores are added at 10 percent.

Number of Wins will be used as a tie breaker

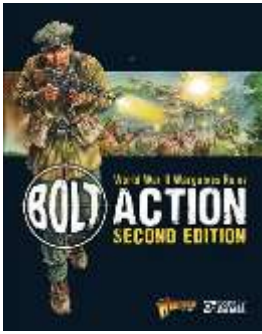

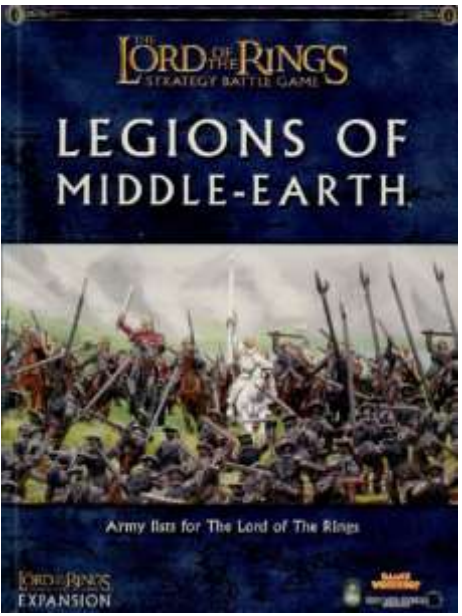

# FoWSA tournaments for 2017

The mid war tournament will be themed to the Stalingrad campaign, and will include at least one 3'x4' urban table for fighting in built up areas. Yes, this will affect choice of lists! But note that any category of troops will be historical: The Germans committed a Panzer division to Stalingrad.

# Battle Report

From: Leitenant Wicker, komandir  
1st company, 42nd rifle BN

To: Major Nesterov, komandir, 42nd Rifle BN

Date: 1 DEC 16 (September 1941)

Subject: Battle Report, Village of Boroyava near Smolensk.



Enemy Forces: (Oscar Barela) elements of the Spanish Division 262nd INF Regiment: 6xINF Squads, 1xPZR1, Kradschuzen with side car, 1x Horsch vehicle w/towed PAK 36, 1xATR team, 1xmedium mortar team, 1xMMG team, and a HQs section.

Friendly Forces: 1xBA 6 Armored car, 1xOT-26 Flame tank, 1x HQs section, 1xATR team, 1x100mm mortar, 4xINF squads (Otdelenniy Komandir [OK or Squad Leader] Bodnar in charge of the SMG squad), 1xCavalry squad, 1xMMG team, 1xSniper team, and 1xM1 Halftrack.



**Situation:** Reacting to orders from STAVKA, what was left of my company was ordered to slow the advance of the oncoming German assault near Smolensk. My company was strung out in column formation for 1 mile and no intelligence had been received on the Germans in our sector. My orders to find the enemy and destroy him with a hasty attack. Unintentionally, I encountered Spaniards in the village Boroyava.



I set up the 100mm Mortar on my left flank with great fields of fire despite nearby woods. The MMG came in next and deployed near the mortar team. I sent 3rd and 4th Squads up the middle with the M1 and it's .50 CAL on my right flank to suppress the enemy's advance. In the first 15 minutes of the battle, Starshina (SGM) Kirichenko laid down effect mortar fire by destroying the Horsch car pulling the PAK 36 and their ATR team. The BA 6 arrived on the scene about the same time their PZR 1 arrived. The BA 6 quickly struck the tank causing it to go hull down but it quickly recovered after that and started to lay down suppressive fire on my center. Muddy weather prevented both sides from receiving re-enforcements for 30 minutes of the battle.



As we exchanged shots the OT26 boldly advanced to eliminate the lead squad on my right flank. After giving that squad a dose of flammable liquid and causing 5 of 8 KIAs, the PAK 36 (which had somehow managed to avoid being destroyed when the Horsch was blasted to bits) struck the OT 26 in the left side and destroyed it. With only the M1 and my spotter on the right flank, my right flank attack ground to a halt so I focused on the center and left flank.





At this point, I could see some Germans entering the village on my left flank and my 2 remaining squads were nowhere in sight. I sent sharpshooter Zheleznov into a building ahead of me which would give us excellent fields of fire on the majority of the German units. I sent the cavalry squad to support him but a devastating burst of fire wiped them out to the last man! The German officer reacted quickly and sent his newly arrived squad and the Kradshutzen to force him out (which they did). The BA 6 poured fire into the newly arrived squad and caused many casualties until that blasted PAK 36 struck it with an APR in the side and destroyed it too.



The battle was not lost just yet however. My two remaining squads arrived (about 1 hour after the first shots were fired), and ordered them to press the attack on my right with the M1 halftrack. OK Bodnar mounted the M1 and aggressively attacked the 2 squads there. Despite heavy casualties from a MMG and two squads, he took the objective! I was wounded at this point so turned command over to OK Bodnav. 2d Squad supported OK Bodnav in taking his objective. 3rd squad, on my left flank, rushed into the bldg. Zheleznov vacated and was wiped out but not until he caused many fatalities to the Germans.

With no armor support left, and the Germans having the numerical advantage in the center (Sharpshooter Zheleznov and the ATR team were killed in the center), I pulled what was left of my company to the Northeast and surrendered the village of Boroyava to the Spaniards.

Logistics: My wounds are heavy but I shall serve the Motherland again! We'll need a new flame tank and BA 6 armored car.
