An Army for All Occasions

I recently finished the first portion of what I have been calling my Anyhammer army project.



This was my last major lockdown project. The idea here was to paint up one army that I could use for any number of fantasy and historical systems. Because the intent was to have the most possible crossover, I chose 28mm (non-heroic) scale and individual 25mm circular basing. Models were chosen to be "historically plausible" or when fantasy to be fairly subdued or even "Oldhammer" seeming. Without any movement trays this force is ready to play, Warlords of Erehwon, Saga, Lion (or Dragon) Rampant. With the correct movement trays this same force will serve in games of Oathmark, Kinds of War, and Warhammer Fantasy (would work best in 3rd edition).

I also added some helpless peasants, adventurers, and creepy crawlies, which allows this project to also see service playing Frostgrave, Rangers of Shadowdeep, or even Advanced Heroquest if I were to dust it off sometime.





For the bulk of the army, I was sure to choose human sculpts for the 13th century. This meant mostly just quilted or chainmail and heater shields and helms. I used models from a number of manufacturers, but the bulk were sourced from Crusader Miniatures. Others came from Footsore's Baron's War line, Red Box Games, 1st Corps, Atlantis Miniatures, and some truly old (as in lead) Citadel Miniatures.



For now, the army is built around a big block of Foot Knights, backed up by plenty of Archers.



Only two proper mounted Knights have been painted yet, but more are coming. For now they will get played as heroes or champions alongside some of the exotic support like these bears.



The heavy hitters of the army though are these Ogres.



Every army needs some leaders. I have done up a lord to march with the Foot Knights, and a pair of sorceress, witches, or whatever title feels appropriate to provide the force with some spellcasting ability.



No fantasy army is complete without a monster or two, and this one is no exception. I assume this Jabberwock is part of the force due to the sorcery of the two spellcasters somehow.





The project is playable as is, but I will probably keep adding to it. I have planned to bulk out the mounted Knights, and give the Foot Knights a couple blocks of Spearmen to protect their flanks. There is also a catapult in a box somewhere...

I just finished organizing my Bolt Action and Flames of War armies. Bolt Action on the right and Flames of War on the left.

Guard Corps!!!




Charlie Torok - I also use plastic containers. I line the bottom of the tubs with magnetic sheets and all my figures (individual and movement stands) have metal bottoms. I also label the tubs for easy recognition when stacked.





