




Zulu Skirmish Game

While fun to play with three to four Units on a side, Zulu plays best at "Tournament" or "Grand Scale Skirmish" level for those that like six or even more Units in their Table Top Army.



Use your own 28mm Colonial figures. For those that prefer15mm or smaller simply use centimeters instead of the listed inches.



The Zulu Play area consists of "On-Board" and "Off-Board" play. On-Board Play is for the majority of Game Play. While there is just enough Off-Board play to capture the unique historical flavor of the Zulu Wars!





Our Game play for Millennium Con will consist of one Zulu Ibutho Commander (General) with three subordinate Impi Commanders vs. one British General and three Battalion Commanders. We will be playing one Scenarios on Saturday Morning and one on Saturday Afternoon! Observers and Friends Welcome!

Gunfighter's Ball Western Game Seymour, Texas 5/22/2021

Five intrepid wargamers ventured west from the greater DFW metropolitan area to Seymour, Texas, where the Kisinger hacienda and gaming emporium are located. Paul "Granpa" Kisinger hosted a game of Gunfighter's Ball (western gunfight genre) that is available from Knuckleduster Miniatures. They sell the rules, miniatures, and accessories. Paul also supplied two of his grandsons to supplement the game players and bring the total to eight.



Everyone had very little or no experience with the rules set so this was intended to be a learning session. Paul had set up the western town and had provisions for ten players. The scenario was based on a hidden cash box that was located in one of four buildings. This helped so that only those buildings needed to be "searched". Mrs. Melody Kisinger hid the cash box and also provided Miss Kitty in the Sassy Gal Saloon with the location. So, talking to Miss Kitty could reveal where the money was.

Seven of the players were cowboys looking to locate and keep the money. Marshall Matt Dillon and deputy Festus were opposing the cowboys and had to guard the dough. Jeff Hunt, of Bloody Broadsides fame, drew the lucky chit that had him defending the cash box. He would play both characters. The other players had a single cowboy each.

Each character had either a repeating rifle or a pistol. In a fiendish twist, Paul had also given each cowboy a stick of dynamite! This would prove interesting.

The cowboys: Red Springs Ranger – Grant Johnson Jingle Bob John – Jeff Key Maverick– Greg Horner Bat Masterson – Paul Kisinger Pancho – Wyatt Struder Lefty – Cole Chandler Johnny Ringo – Chuck Gibke



NPC - Miss Kitty

The cowboys all started from different directions and began heading toward the center of town. Ultimately Ranger, Maverick, and Jingle Bob were able to talk to Miss Kitty and get the location of the money which was hidden in the sheriff's office. We kind of figured this out since both Matt and Festus were stationed there. Two of the three (I think Mav and Jingle Bob) were at the saloon at the same time and agreed to ally and split the loot. Trying to move inside a building, Johnny Ringo was caught in bushwhack by rifle totting Festus, firing three shots. Jeff Hunt was hot on the dice and hit all three, wounding Johnny in both legs and the back, limiting him to crawling and down to two red chips. JR would spend the rest of the game crawling for cover and then off the board. If I remember correctly, Jeff missed on his next nine rolls for either Matt or Festus. Sheesh.



Bat Masterson moved through the space between the sheriff's office and another building when the marshal shot Pancho, wounding him. However, Pancho tossed a dynamite stick and blew the front of the sheriff's office to bits. No injuries, however, to either Matt or Bat.

Lefty spent most of his time checking out the railway station but didn't find anything. He finally tried to head for the saloon by crossing behind the hardware store but spooked Ranger who hit him with multiple shots. Another observer reported that it was by rifle fire from Festus in the sheriff's office that got him. Regardless, Lefty died in the street.

With Ranger climbing up and lying prone on the second story of the saloon, he had "bushwhack" engaged on the side door of the Sherriff's office. This means he will shoot anyone appearing in or around the doorway, friend or foe. I thought Jeff Hunt jumped 3 feet in the air when Maverick charged up to the door and Jeff announced the bushwhack! It was great. However, Maverick survived.

Now, Pancho was not pleased with being shot at by Ranger, so he crawled over and grabbed the dynamite stick from Lefty's dead body and tossed it at the saloon. It exploded underneath the corner where Ranger was lying on the second floor. The fall and explosion, plus the secondary explosion when Ranger's dynamite stick went off meant the end of Ranger. Johnny Ringo was able to crawl off the board in hopes of getting medical attention, so Jeff Hunt gave Festus to Chuck to play. This turned out to be ominous.

The final scene had Maverick, Jingle Bob, and Bat all converging on the sheriff's office. Festus was killed in the shootout by Bat who was then mortally wounded by Matt in return. Matt took fire from two directions and was wounded down to the three red chips, Jingle Bob supplying 2 or 3 close range hits. Matt threw in the towel at that point and it is assumed that the three cowboys split the cash. They left Pancho in the street to fend for himself.



The undertaker had his work cut out for him. Chuck was the only player to have two characters killed.

I think everyone enjoyed the game and were pleased with the rules set. We were able to check out many of the nuances. Games in the future should go faster. Paul's western town was top notch. Did I mention that lunch was supplied by Melody who cooked ribs on her new grill? It was excellent.

Several of us have been trying to encourage Forrest Harris, owner of Knuckleduster Miniatures, to attend Millennium Con this November. Regardless, there will probably be a game or two of Gunfighter's Ball in the offing.

 Participation - Players are visibly enjoying the game, and all players asked respond enthusiastically

 GM Effort - For a GM going "above-and-beyond" to run many events, and/or large fun games or over a dozen gamers, informative/educational or multimedia efforts such as historical posters, flags, AV etc.


HoTW After Action Altar of Freedom Game Alan Spencer







Tournament Rules

1. FORCES

Players must use a 1,250-requisition point force for the 1st round, 1,000requisition point force for the 2nd round, 750-requisition point force for the 3rd round and 500-requisition point force for the 4th round. Players may change their force composition each round, but the force Nationality may not change.

This will be a de-escalation event. All forces must consist of a maximum of **ONE** Reinforced Platoon and no more than 14 order dice. Tank Platoons with a maximum armor of 7 **will** be allowed. NO Special Characters, No Planes from the PDF supplement.

The platoons in the force must be selected using the army list section of the main rule book, one of the Armies of xxxx books, or an Approved Generic list of a minor country that does not have an Armies of xxxx book. All lists must be a generic platoon, No theater list.

2. GAME TIME

2hr30min Round 01, 2hr Round 02, 1hr30min Round 03, 1hr Round 04. Once time is up players will finish the current turn, and then the game ends automatically.

3. ARMY LIST

The players must have copies of their army list, Army list are due 19 JULY 21. 5 bonus TP for early list submissions.

List submissions will be submitted by sending to raidersfan26@hotmail.com

4. TOURNAMENT POINTS (TP)

Victory is calculated as described in the Scenarios being played and Tournament points are awarded for victories, defeats and draws as shown below:

Result	Tournament Points
Victory/Loss	20 TP / 0 TP
Draw	10 TP / 10 TP

From the second round, players will be paired using a Swiss system (i.e., matching players on the same number of TPs, in descending order).

5. WINNING THE TOURNAMENT

The winner is determined at the end of the last round, according to the following criteria:

- The player with the most TP will be the winner.
- In case of same TP at the top, the winner will be the player with the highest Casualty points total.
- Sportsmanship, Painting, and theme will also factor into a separate overall score.







WW III update. Two games last night.


The first game saw Nathanael (T-80s) attack Branden (French Infantry) in the counterattack mission.


WW II Update. Our first game last night had Nathanael (Soviet Heavy Assault Gun) attack Mark Reed (British Cromwells) in the Bridgehead mission.



It was a hard fought battle but the British were out-gunned and out-armored by the heavy Soviet armor force. The British did exact three units of casualties prior to succumbing to a game winning tank assault by the ISU-122s with the IS-2 formation commander joining in.



The second game saw Steve (Sturm Grenadiers) attack Chris (US Rifle company) in the counterattack mission. The theme of the night was awe inspiring American shooting followed by nearly equally amazing saves by the Germans.



The Germans looked to get the better of the Americans early when in spite of 6 out of 8 hits by the M-10s in ambush needing 5+ on the StuGs resulting in only a single kill. The return fire took out 3 of the 4 M-10s.



American reserves came on slowly but when they did they took out one of the two tigers. The American rifle platoon near the right objective was pinned and couldn't immediately get on the objective which left it very contestable. The German Sturm platoon that was bearing down on this objective rallied nearly every time and absorbed a great amount of firepower while remaining relatively intact. An assault by the grenadiers was just barely pinned which kept the Americans contesting the objective. The last turn saw the last tiger try to assault the infantry. An M-10 hit in defensive fire but the tiger saved it.




The OP Sherman got a hit which bailed the tiger and caused him to break off and finally Bazooka Bert who was pinned did not want to miss the action and hit the tiger as well causing a double bail whereupon the tiger failed his remount to stay on the battlefield and the game was called. 
PROHIBITIONERA 28mm Gaming by Blake Radetsky




During this past COVID year and combined with the Deep Freeze, has forced me to spend more time out in the barn.


