25 December 1776



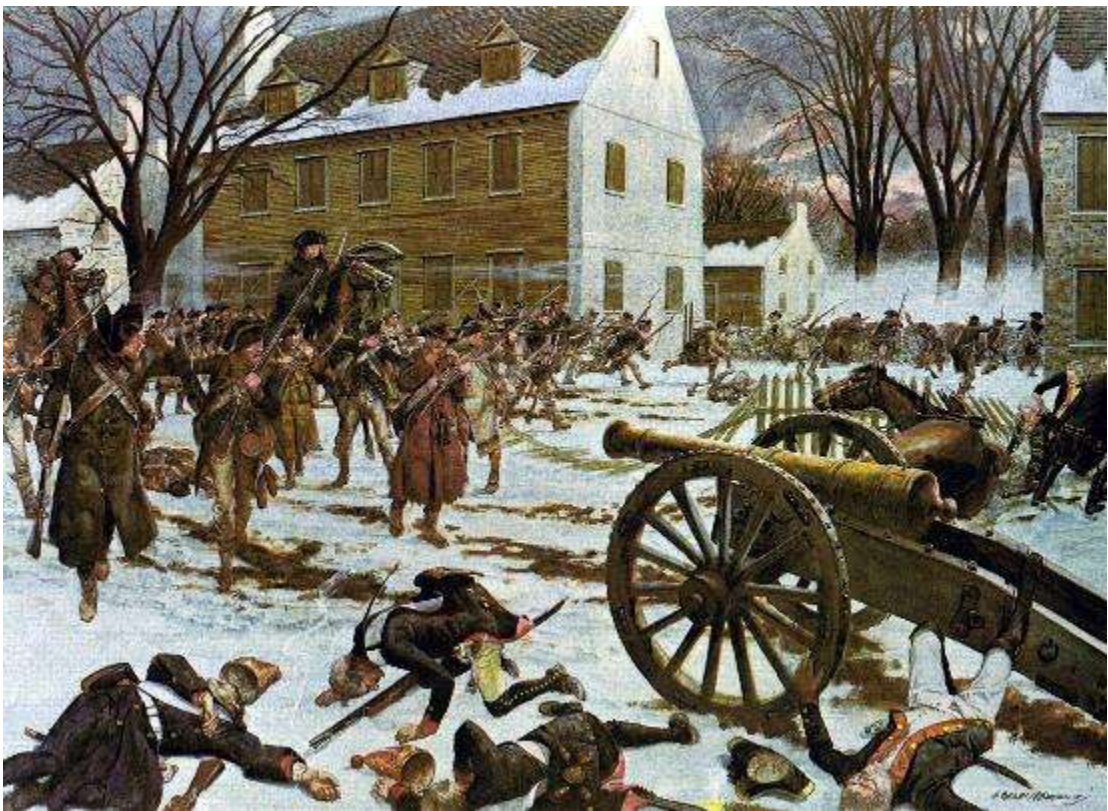

My 6mm Rommel Project

WWII Rommel Game After Action Report
Heart of Texas Wargamers
Submitted by Alan Spencer



On Sunday Dec 19, members of our local Heart of Texas Wargamers club gathered to play a game of Rommel by Sam Mustafa. Byron Milsap played the Axis forces (DAK 2nd Light Div, Italian Pavia and Ariste Divisions) and David Fram the British (2nd Armor and 3rd Indian Brigade of the Western Desert Force (WDF)). I was the GM for the game. The battle chosen was the 2nd Battle of Mechili, July 4, 1941.

Victory in the battle was for the Axis to hold 3 objectives by game's end. Any other result was a British victory.

Second Battle of Mechili Opening moves



The weather is clear. All units start in supply. Objectives are shown as stars. ☠ = minefields

The wadis, mountains and soft ground were all rough terrain.

The opening moves saw elements of the 5th Light Div advance and surprise attack (event option) on the British reconnaissance Otter armored cars, which were caught and destroyed.



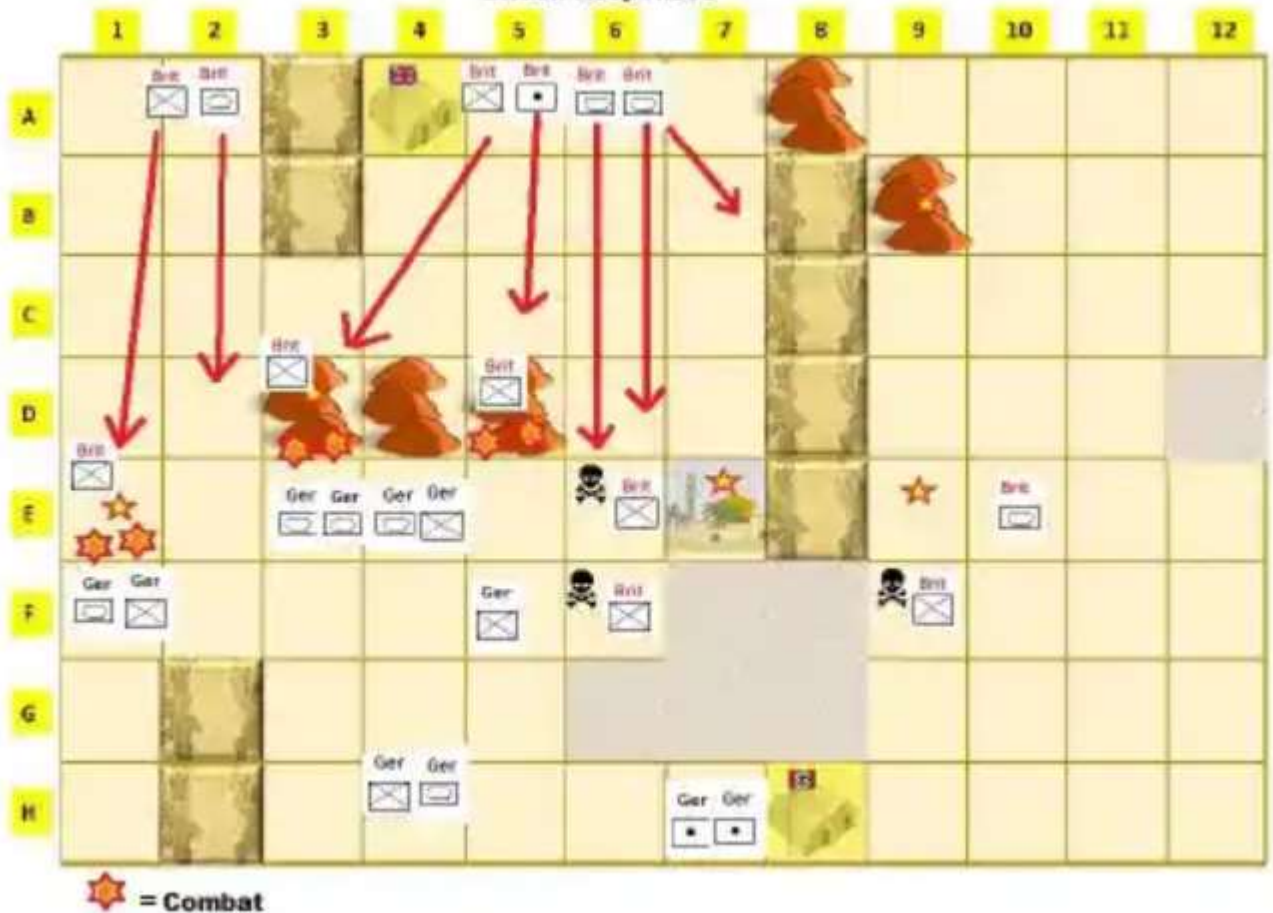
Advance of the 5th Light Div

The British suffered the loss of their reconnaissance unit with typical stiff upper lip, with the supporting infantry falling back to the rocky hills, holding onto Objective #2 (D3).

Just to their west, other British infantry holding onto Objective #1 (E1), felt they could not make it back to the hills, so decided to dig in and make Jerry work for it. And the work was a butcher's bill to both sides.

British Responses



Meanwhile, the rest of the 2nd Light Div of the DAK arrived and pressed on toward the hills, bypassing Mechili for now.

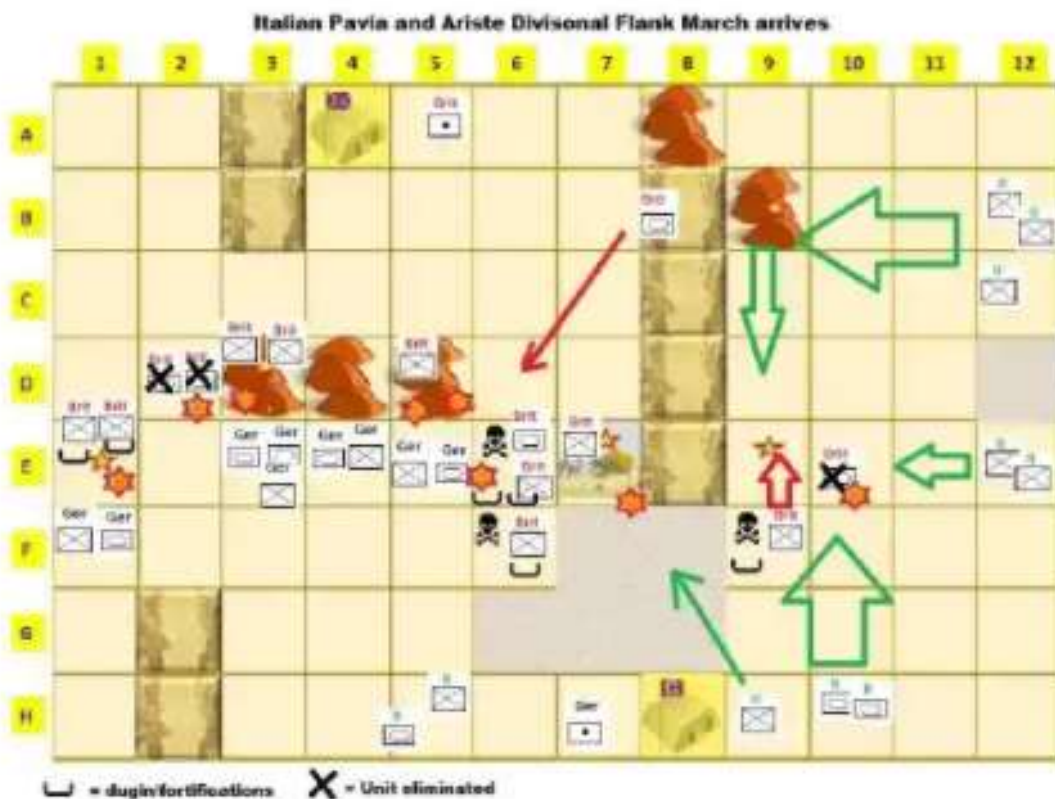
British reinforcements arrived on turn 2. At which point, the battle became one of attrition, with the British losing an artillery battalion at Objective 3 (D5), clinging onto the hills, denying the DAK from advancing further. The playing of the "dig in" option helped the British immensely at this point.

The British Vickers tanker quickly went to the front on the western flank, taking on the Pz II's in an even match around D2 and E3, preventing the infantry holding Objective 1 from being isolated.

It was at this point, the wily desert fox (Byron) chose to delay entry of some Italian forces, until they could come in from the east (column 12) on turn 5 (an option in the scenario). And when they did, it was the boost the Axis needed to break the stalemate.





Italian flank march arrives!

The British Vicker tanks near Objective 2 were blasted away with the arrival of a company of Pz IIIs. This freed up the light Pz IIs to encircle the British at Objective 1, isolating them.

Once isolated at Objective 1, the British infantry could not reorganize and recover. This left them exposed and weakened, as their fortifications had been blown away by previous assaults.

And sure enough, this was the time the Luftwaffe finally evaded the RAF, and a Stuka Squadron arrived to help blast the reeling British at Objective 1, allowing the Panzers and following Italian infantry to capture the position at last.



Blitzkrieg at Obj 1!

Over on the eastern flank, Italian forces captured Object 4 (B9) uncontested, and swung south to support the Ariste Div's attack on Objective 5 (E9).

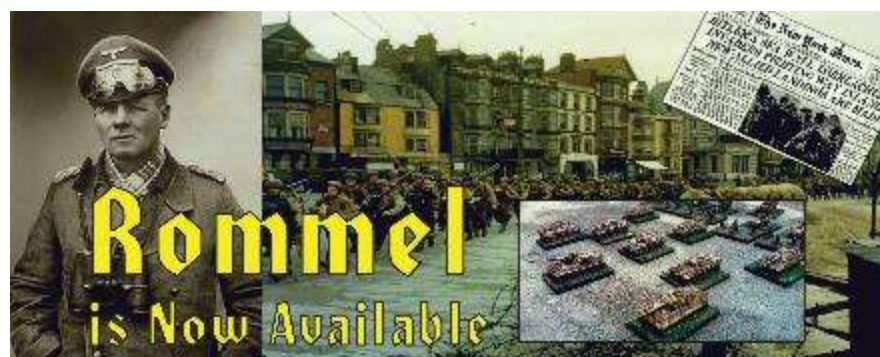
After the Italians, who captured 2 objectives (they say 3 since they rolled through Objective 1 fast), and third objective was captured, the British decided to cut their losses and bail. They had no reinforcements left to attempt to recapture them.

While the DAK was fairly well battered too – the Italians were mostly fresh and on the move.

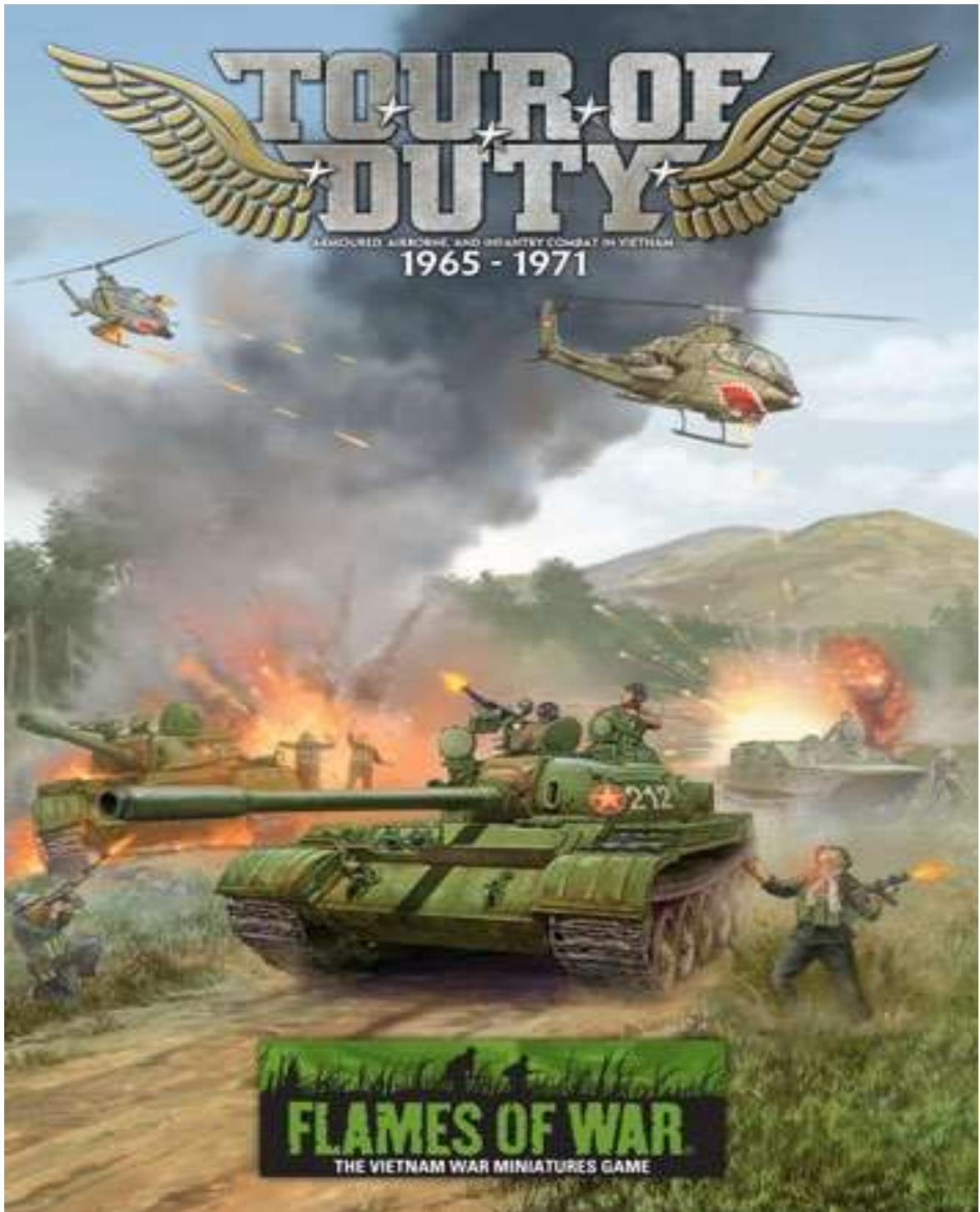

In the end, the PAVN beat the Pattons while the Sheridans bested the T-55s (Pics 10-17). The game was a draw at the end called due to time.



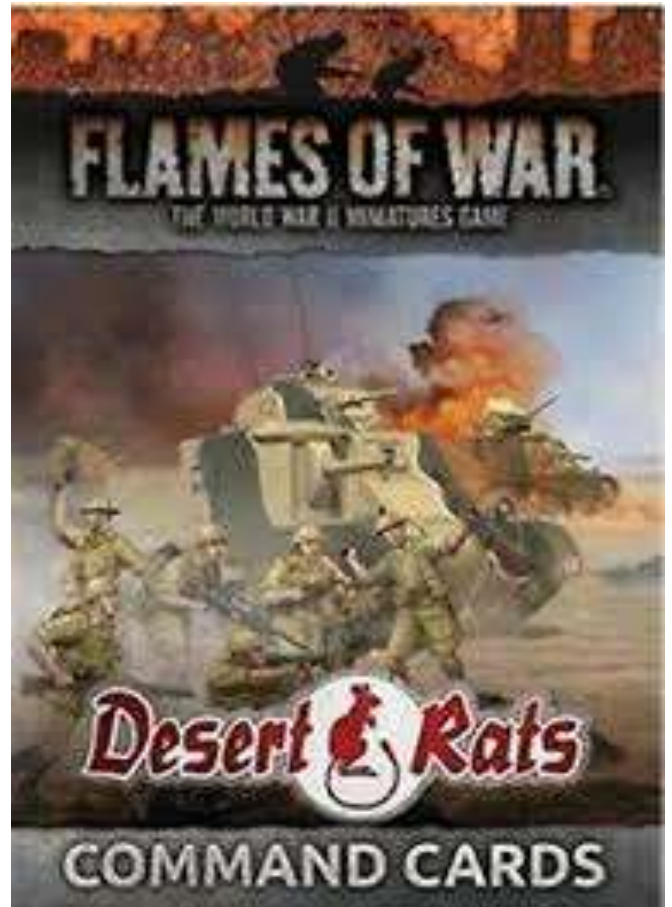
